The Tradition of Sharing Oplatki
An eastern European tradition, oplatki, Bread of Lave, is a rectangular wafer imprinted with a nativity scene, symbolizing unity, love, and reconcillation within the family. Before Christmas Eve dinner, family and friends break a piece off the wafer, offering it to one another to eat, expressing wishes for and a blessing on each, and asking forgiveness if needed. A colored wafer is given the animals, who were present at Jesus' birth too. Sharing oplatki is a family celebration of love.

Next weekend after all masses, packets of oplatki (with directions for celebrating this tradition) will be available at no cost for those who would like to add or continue this custom on the holy eve of Christmas.
