This Thursday will mark the 48th anniversary of the Apollo 11 Moon Landing. The Gemini and Apollo programs have always captured my imagination, so I have to mention it in hopes that it will capture or recapture yours. I'm always in awe and amazed at the primitive (by today's standards) technology that sent those astronauts from the earth to the moon. I don't remember Apollo 11 (wasn't born yet, feel old?), but I do remember the launch party for Apollo 17 and everyone up on the neighbor's roof pointing at the rocket in the night sky when we lived in Florida. Years ago there was a TV special on PBS marking the twenty-fifth anniversary and it interviewed a number of Apollo astronauts about their experiences, and an interesting consensus emerged – There is an intelligence to the universe. It's not random, haphazard, or thrown together in a chaotic way. There is order and it makes sense. Some even spoke of experiencing something greater at work, even naming it Divine. All that came to mind when Paul mentions that "all creation is groaning," awaiting the glory to be revealed. Creation itself is touched by and pointing the way to God.

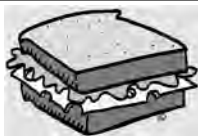
Prayer Chain

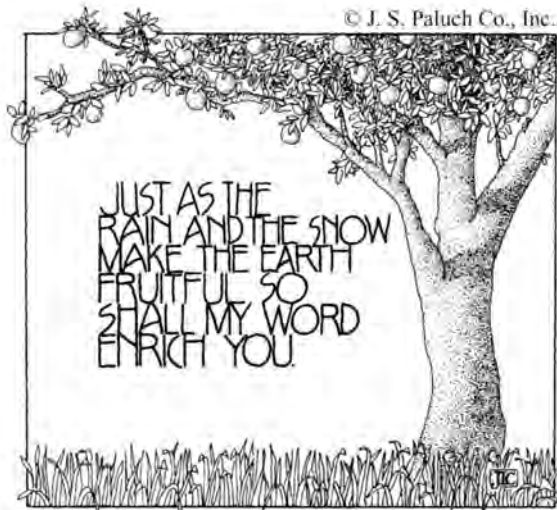
