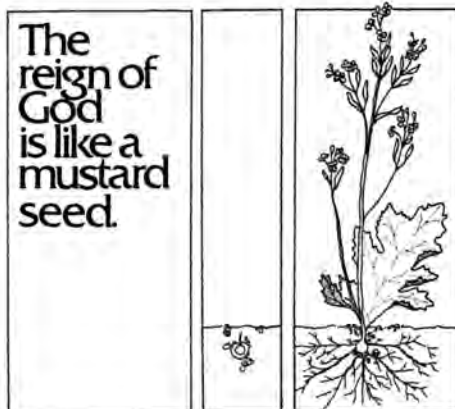

Guess what we hear about in the Gospel this week? More seeds. I've gone as far as I can with oxen, seeds, dirt, and farming in general, so let's embrace the Spirit! Paul doesn't use the word, but he does describe the Spirit in the role of Advocate (John's Gospel) this week, helping us in our prayer. I think the essence of prayer is to be engaged with God. For each person it's different, but basically prayer is being engaged with God. Thomas Aquinas says that the intention to pray is the most important first step. The mind can wander and we can be distracted, but that original intention is what makes our prayer fruitful – there is no prayer without the intention to start praying. Yes, we can gain much more from the experience if we are present in the experience, but the most important thing is the desire to be engaged with God. That's always the first step. So, let's take the first step and let the Advocate help us the rest of the way!

## Parish Library

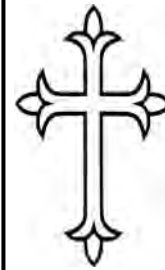
