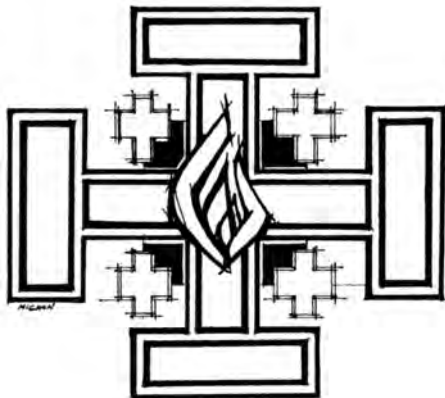

So, you want to be a prophet? Jeremiah gives us a pretty good job description of what that means – rejection, persecution, and martyrdom. I'm not sure if Paul was conscious of it, but he seems to conform himself to the mold of Jeremiah. His mission of proclaiming the Good News is fraught with peril – rejection, persecution, and maybe even death. Why would anyone even start an endeavor with such an ending? Jeremiah explains why in the verses just preceding where he is wrestling with the Lord (which we will encounter in about two weeks! How's that for continuity problems?). To paraphrase, "I can't help myself. I don't want to, but every fiber of my being compels me to be the Lord's prophet!" I'm not there yet. Many times I still have to consciously think about exercising my discipleship. May we all reach the point where it becomes second nature and we cannot help but be the Lord's own disciples.
