



Centering Prayer

Centering Prayer is a form of contemplative prayer, wordless, in which a person simply experiences God's presence. It was developed in the 1970'sby Trappist monks to revive the Christian contemplative tradition. The name 'centering prayer' was derived fron Trappist Thomas Merton, who once noted that contemplative prayer is "centered entirely in the presence of God."

There are two opportunities each week to join in contemplative Centering Prayer at Corpus Christi,,,Tuesdays at 7pm and Wednesdays at 1pm. All are welcome to join.

Financial Peace University

Twenty-four families just graduated from Dave Ramsey's Financial Peace University here are Corpus Christi. The class took a 10-week journey through 9 classes that educated students on a simple 7-step process to achieving financial peace. The class paid off \$95,391 in non-mortgage debt, an average of \$3,974 per family and increased their savings by \$127,984, and average of \$5,332. That's a \$9,306 average improvement per family in just 10 weeks. The class would like to thank John Bridges for entertaining the children of our students.
