Paul has the unfortunate reputation for being pompous and arrogant, and I think that's unfair to Paul. We only have half of the correspondence when we read his letters, and it's like eavesdropping on half a phone conversation. We constantly have to read between the lines and fill in the blanks. Otherwise he may come across as full of himself - "Keep on doing what you have learned and received and heard and seen in me. Then the God of peace will be with you." There's a danger in taking that line as Paul wants everybody to be just like him because he's so great. We miss the context. Remember, the Damascus event changed Paul. He had a new mission, a new purpose, and a new life. His was now to proclaim the Gospel of Christ Jesus, to live in Christ, and have Christ dwelling in him. He was fervent in trying to become the best disciple he could be, and encouraging others to become the best they could be. So what did the Philippians learn, receive, hear, and see in Paul? Christ Jesus himself! May we, too, convey that same Christ Jesus to all we encounter.

Sept. Monthly Loan Payment: \$ 21,000

(\$12,500 principal; \$8,500 interest)

Sept. Parishioner Donations/Pledges Received: \$ 43,000

Parishioner Pledge Payments Remaining: \$ 200,000 *

* These remaining pledge payments, when received over the next several months, will allow us to pay down the mortgage to a balance owed of \$1,700,000. A successful <u>Faithfully Following Campaign</u> will allow us to continue paying down our loan.
