From the Desk of Fr. Chris



It was a tremendous revelation to learn that the same person wrote Luke's Gospel and Acts of the Apostles. I was also deflated to learn that there is no evidence that it's the Luke we find in Acts, or that the author's actual name was Luke. Whatever the author was called by friends, the name we know and use is Luke; it's our pen-name for the writer. Today we have two different passages from Luke, one from the end of his Gospel and the other from the beginning of his Acts of the Apostles. What strikes me is the similarity of themes and phrasing. Jesus explains the scriptures and tells the disciples, "You are witnesses of these things." Then we have Peter (in the first reading) proclaiming, "Of this we are witnesses!" That word, "witness", is important for Luke; it's the thrust of discipleship. It comes from the Greek "martureis", to witness, testify, or attest. Easy to see our English word Martyr. Probably no one here will be remembered as a great martyr of the faith, but each is still called, by our words, by our actions, by our presence, to bear witness and to give testimony!

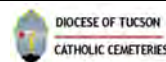

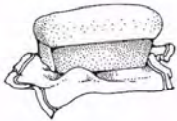

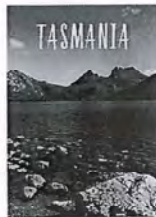

Apr 1. Monthly Loan Payment: \$ 21,000
(\$13,600 principal; \$7,400 interest)
