From the Desk of Fr. Chris



Happy Easter! It's still Easter day – a feast so grand that we celebrate it for eight days, Sunday to Sunday. Even more than that, it's a season of 50 days. In Church parlance, Easter is the whole time from Easter Sunday to Pentecost Sunday. Here are some catchy ways to remember that fact: We fasted for 40 days; we feast for 50 days to show that "God is greater than our hearts." (1Jn 3:20) Easter is a week of weeks – $7 \times 7 \text{ days} + 1 = 50$. That extra day is eschatological, the day beyond the week – the first day of the new creation. The Feast of Weeks in Greek is "Pentecost," literally 50 days. In our Jewish roots "Pentecost" referred to the feast of Shavuot, the giving of the Torah at Mt. Sinai 50 days after Passover. For us, "Pentecost" is the giving of the Holy Spirit 50 days after the Resurrection. So for the next month and a half, Happy Easter!
