From the Desk of Fr. Chris



Radical words from Jesus in the Gospel – He who feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood has life eternal, and I will raise him on the last day. Imagine hearing those words for the first time, having someone tell you that you must eat their flesh and drink their blood? We'll see next week how the reality of that language proves an obstacle to the disciples. At the same time that language, as strong as it is, uncompromising as it is, is an assurance to us about Jesus' seriousness in giving himself in the sacrament that we now know as the Eucharist. The realism of it is unmistakable - it is sacrificial language. In making the bread and wine his own flesh and blood, and in bidding us to eat and drink, he is linking four realities in an unbreakable, intimate bond: himself, his death on Calvary and resurrection, the bread and wine, and us.

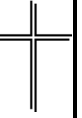

Centering Prayer

Centering Prayer is a form of contemplative prayer, wordless, in which a person simply experiences God's presence. It was developed in the 1970's by Trappist monks to revive the Christian contemplative tradition. The name "centering prayer" was derived from Trappist Thomas Merton, who once noted that contemplative prayer is "centered entirely in the presence of God."

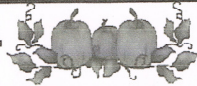

Corpus Christi Building Mortgage Loan Update

Building Loan Balance Owed: \$ 1,548,000 *

August 1 Monthly Loan Payment: \$ 21,000

(\$14,600 principal; \$6,400 interest)
