

#### From the Desk of Fr. Chris



"Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice!" The Third Sunday of Advent is traditionally called Gaudete Sunday. from the Latin for rejoice. We move into the homestretch of the season. The mood is a little more festive today. Liturgically, today we move from the dark, somber hues to the lighter – the pink (rose?) colored candle is lit on the wreathe to help signify this movement. A little Advent history. In its origins, Advent was very Lent-like with a fast of 40 days and a more penitential character in preparation for the celebration of Christmas. There are references to "St. Martin's Lent" in the 5th century, since Advent began the day after the feast of Martin (Nov 12). By the 9th century, Advent became a season of four weeks, with Gaudete Sunday being preserved as a kind of respite of the season and foretaste of the wonderful celebration to come. This Sunday we're saying in a liturgical way "Keep at it. There's light at the end of the tunnel!" But when you think about it, whenever we come together with our Lord, no matter the season and no matter the Sunday, it's a great time of celebration and joy! So, remember what Paul tells the Philippians, "Rejoice in the Lord always. I shall say it again: rejoice!"

The Tradition of Sharing Oplatki

An eastern European tradition, oplatki, Bread of Love, is a rectangular wafer imprinted with a nativity scene, symbolizing unity, love, and reconciliation within the family. Before Christmas Eve dinner, family and friends break a piece off the wafer, offering it to one another to eat, expressing wishes for and a blessing on each, and asking forgiveness if needed. A colored wafer is given the animals, who were present at Jesus' birth too. Sharing oplatki is a family celebration of love.
