In the ancient world, the term leprosy covered a multitude of ailments, not just Hansen's Disease. The end result was a person on the outside looking in, on the fringe and not part of the community. We've all crossed paths with such individuals – at school, work, clubs, even at Church. We may have felt that way at times. Through today's Gospel, Jesus shows his disciples what stand to take. "Moved with pity, he stretched out his hand, touched him, and said to him, 'I do will it. Be made clean.'" He is moved with pity. The Greek word, *splankna*, literally means out of the guts – with feeling from the core of one's being. Compassion. And He touched him. He made a connection and started a relationship. "I do will it. Be made clean" - I can and will change this situation. "Made clean" is bringing a person back into the group. It's tough; it takes courage; it takes risk; and it is part of following Jesus.

Lenten Regulations on Fast & Abstinence

Ash Wednesday, February 14, marks the beginning of Lent. The following fasting and abstinence regulations are observed:

Abstinence from meat is observed on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent by all Catholics 14 years and older.

Fasting is observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those bound by this rule may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted as necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.

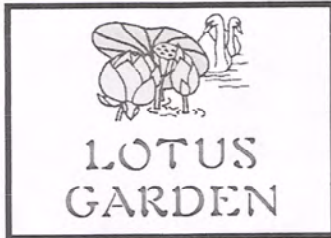

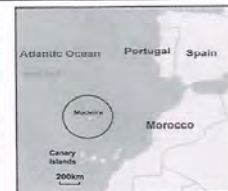
