RECEIVING THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST AT MASS

As we begin our Lenten journey, intent on Jesus and His love and sacrifice for us, let us refocus on how we approach receiving Him in the Eucharist:

- 1. **Approach** the Host or the Cup, then...
- 2. Bow. This is not a profound bow, but a bow of the head only, to the Host or Precious Blood (not to the back of the person in front of you). After you bow, the minister will say:

 "The Body (Blood) of Christ", then...



3. <u>Respond</u>: "Amen." After you have said, "Amen," the minister will give you Communion.

From St. Cyril of Jerusalem: "...make one hand a throne for the other, as for that which is to receive a King. And having hallowed your palm, receive the Body of Christ."








If you have eligibility questions, please send a note to **safeenvironment@cccctucson.org** and you will be instructed as to what may need to be completed. As of 2/6/18, there are 166 current volunteers who have not completed the training.

The ACT of Lent

Last week, Liturgical Life Ministry invited all to look at our frustrations with the state of the world around us and to decide on an ACTion that each of us WILL work on in ourselves to have a positive effect on ourselves, the community, the world, the environment, an ACTion that will create a sense of peace and reconciliation. If you are finding difficulty doing this, we suggest going to the parish website: www.ccctucson.org and clicking on "Homilies" on the left side of the home page, choosing to listen to Fr. Richard's homily from Jan. 21, "How Big is Your God?" It refers to the story of Jonah and how he did not want to respond to God's request to go to Ninevah to deal with the mean, nasty Assyrians. When he eventually encountered them, he found a people that were other than he expected. The homily deals with the concept of comparing good people vs bad people, black vs white, saints vs sinners, us vs them, only to find out God is on everyone's side. We think this homily may help you decide what ACTion you can take in your own life, write it on the paper square in the narthex, and place it in the basket at the foot of the cross.
