

Building Loan Balance Owed: \$ 1,850,000 \* Jan 1. Monthly Loan Payment: \$ 21,000 (\$13,250 principal; \$7,750 interest)

\* The **Faithfully Following Campaign**, presently underway, is an effort to pay down this remaining mortgage loan balance. Gift donations and pledges received as of January 31 total \$754,000 towards the goal of \$1,100,000. Greater parishioner participation is needed in order to reach the goal and allow us to continue meeting our monthly loan payment responsibility.
