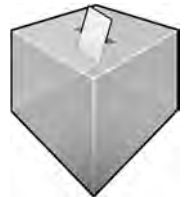

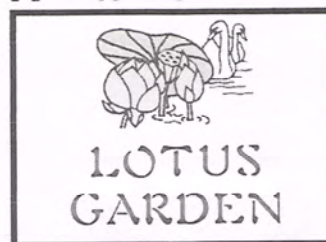

**Dave Ramsey's Financial Peace University Class**

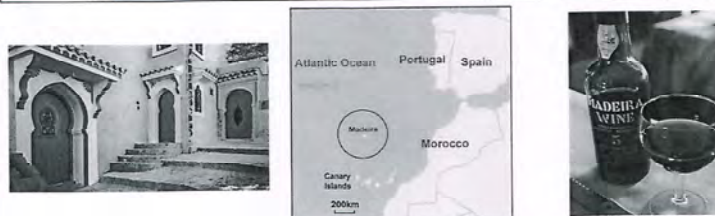
