Migrant shelters provide humanitarian assistance to men, women and children who are deported to Nogales, Sonora; and to migrant families seeking asylum.

Centering Prayer is a form of contemplative prayer, wordless, in which a person simply experiences God's presence. It was developed in the 1970's by Trappist monks to revive the Christian contemplative tradition. The name 'centering prayer' was derived from Trappist Thomas Merton, who once noted that contemplative prayer is "centered entirely in the presence of God."

SMA, as it is known, receives durable medical goods from hospitals, doctors and individuals and then gives away the medical supplies to individuals in AZ and to clinics all over the world. Our warehouse is in Tucson, and we are **a totally volunteer organization**. Our only expenses are operational: office supplies, computers, electricity. In fiscal 2016-17, we shipped more than 51,000 pounds of supplies to destinations in AZ and throughout the world. Of those shipments 44% were in AZ, 7% to Mexico, 35% distributed through the 3000 Club (a sister organization), 1% globally, 2% for Veterinary use and 11% recycled as not suitable for human use.
