

May the Word of God Speak to and Live in Me

At mass each week, the primary of the three readings is the Gospel. Because that is one of four places in the mass where Jesus himself is present, we stand to honor his presence. The Gospel dialogue begins with the sung "Alleluia" ("Praise God!") and continues..."The Lord be with you"..."And with your spirit"..."A reading from the Gospel according to N"..."Glory to you, O Lord," followed by "May the Word of God be on my mind and on my lips and in my heart," as we also make the sign of the cross on our forehead, our lips, and our heart, showing that we belong to Christ in thought, word, and loving action. Prayed in silence in some congregations, Corpus Christi has the tradition of saying these words aloud. In this prayer, we are asking for grace to listen to the Gospel, understand it, and go forth to live it with our lives in a new, transformed way. Please join with the community in speaking these words aloud each week before the Gospel is read.


