Happy Birthday! Pentecost is seen as the birth of the Church, the start of it all. This is the moment when that fearful group was empowered by the Spirit to do what they never thought possible! We have such dramatic descriptions of the event. Tongues of fire descending, strange languages being spoken, and the disciples emboldened to proclaim. What a spectacular event that must have been! The danger of such descriptive language trying to explain a spiritual experience is the temptation to think, "That was way back when. I've never experienced anything like that!" I'd argue just the opposite is true. Notice the way John describes the event and what Jesus says just before he breathes on the apostles – "Peace be with you, and as the Father has sent me, so I send you." There is the assurance of peace – well-being, strength, courage, unity, companionship – and mission – sent out to be the divine presence in the world. Pentecost is still happening, and the Spirit is inviting us to take part!

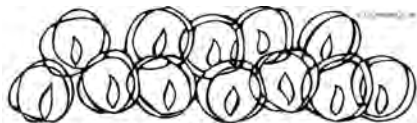
