From the Desk of Fr. Chris



We are winding down the cycle of readings from Mark's Gospel, and I'll be sorry to see him go. Mark is direct and to the point, terse in his writing style (like the Hemingway of Gospel writers). It's also a most challenging Gospel because it holds up unexpected models of faith and action for would be disciples of Jesus. It's not the ones who already think or claim they're religious. It's not his friends. It's always the people who are unlikable, unworthy, or on the fringe. We've had the children, who have no rights but have a claim on the Kingdom, the outsiders - the Gerasene demoniac, the woman with the hemorrhage, and blind Bartimaeus, and today the poor widow with her two small coins. These are the worthy examples of the life Jesus is talking about, for whom the Kingdom is prepared. Before we let go of Mark's Gospel for the year, a valuable question to ask might be: Who is the unexpected person in my life who is teaching me to be a better disciple of Jesus?

## HAND CARVED in BETHLEHEM

Please stop by the tables of religious wares (Nativity sets, rosaries, statues, crucifixes, charms, etc.) after all the masses the weekend of Nov. 17 & 18.

Ayman Khair represents about 180 Christian families from Bethlehem. These families have been dependent upon sales of their hand carved religious articles to tourists of the Holy Land. Due to the conflict in the Middle East, the tourism has been cut off. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United States to purchase their articles. These **hand carved religious articles are beyond description**. Carved from **wood of the sacred olive tree**, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair that these families have a little income and are able to stay living in the Holy Land. Amazingly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22% to less than 2% in the last 30 years. Thank you in advance for your support.

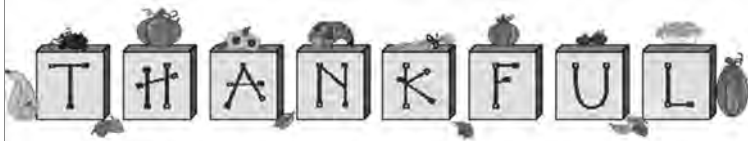
