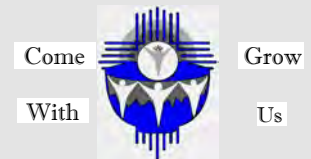

We are winding down the liturgical year. Next week is Christ the King. In two weeks, Advent begins. The themes and images of the end of the old and beginning of the new years are the same – the culmination when God is all in all. So, for the next few weeks we'll have a lot of wild and crazy apocalyptic imagery, as we have from Daniel and Mark. It's always good to remember not to get so lost in the images that we can't see the forest for the trees – it is Good News. Alan Culpepper gives us a lens through which to read these types of passages, "The gospel offers not a way of predicting the end of the world but the spiritual resources to cope with adversity and hardship. In times of distress, "do not be terrified." The message is that every person is living in a time of stress, as each person in every preceding generation, so stick with Jesus. He will get you through all the way to the end. And, by the way, that end is going to be great!
