This is the last Sunday of the liturgical year, our liturgical New Year's Eve, if you will. Commonly referred to as Christ the King, the proper title is a mouthful - The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe. What always strikes me about this and the next two Sundays of Advent is how the themes and celebrations mesh together so smoothly and time seems to fold in on itself. Prominent the next few weeks is the *Parousia*, the second coming. The Greek word itself doesn't really have a qualifier, meaning the presence, attendance, or arrival. From now to Christmas we transition in our celebrations from the second to the first Parousia of Jesus seamlessly. That's true for the daily life of a disciple, too. This time of year, everything around us seems to shift gears. The stress level goes up. Everything and everyone get more busy. We're pulled in many different directions. Don't get lost or jarred about! Keep doing what we always do – remembering who we are and what we are about, discerning what is precious and what is frivolous, and keeping in mind Who is important and Whom we follow.

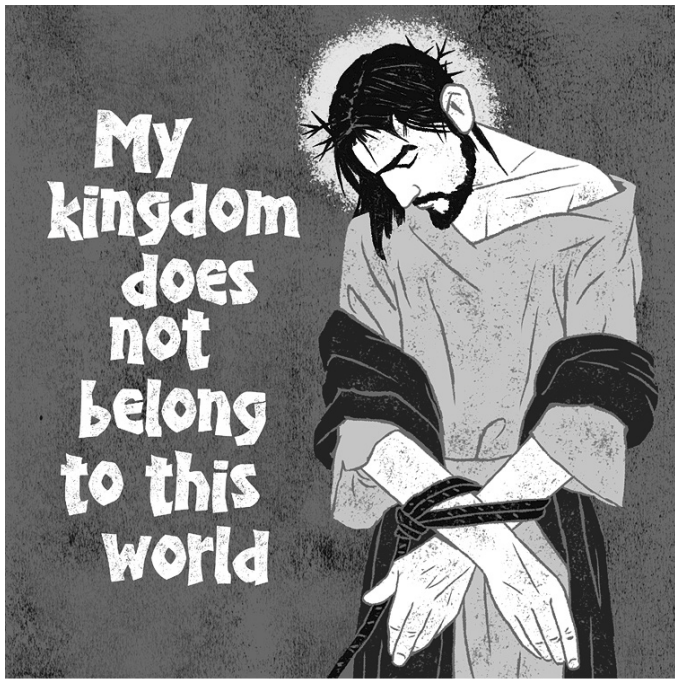

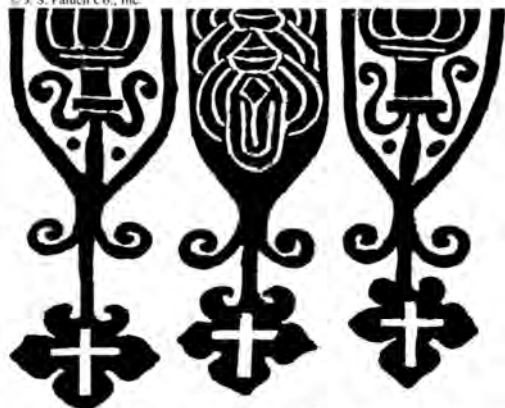
