To be honest, I really don't like the readings for today. It's not Jesus talking about the permanence of the marriage bond; it's the reminder of the reality in which friends find themselves. Often, the ideal and reality seem separated by a chasm. I've been witness to the pain and hurt and guilt and shame of friends, and I know you have, also. For whatever reason or situation our friends find themselves, when our friends and loved ones hurt, we hurt, too! We don't want them to be weighed down and shackled, but to live as ones who are precious and loved, both by us and by God. Maybe we need to remind ourselves that the sacramental character of the marriage bond is that it is a sign and reminder of God's love, a love that is everlasting. God won't stop loving us, ever, not matter what! The most important line of today's Gospel is the last, and we need to remind one another constantly of it - Then he embraced them and blessed them, placing his hands on them.
