In the Gospel Jesus says that "wicked designs come from the deep recesses of the heart." Is the human heart evil? Catholic tradition is fairly optimistic about human nature. We believe in people's basic goodness, though we are capable of inflicting much pain and suffering. The late Dominican writer Gerald Vann describes the human heart this way: "The heart of man is an abyss. There is room in it for infinity because in it there is an infinity of desire; and it cannot remain empty; the stark horror of alien evil will inhabit it if it is not filled by the limitless ocean of the goodness of God." Nature abhors a vacuum. The infinite desire of our hearts will be filled – we choose how it will be filled. It is God's desire that we allow Him to fill us with the limitless ocean of His Goodness.




