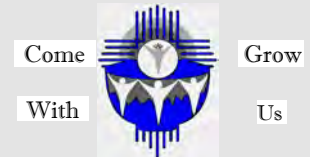

From the Desk of Fr. Chris



"Teacher, we saw someone casting out demons in your name, and we tried to stop him, because he was not following us." A very interesting pronoun ends that sentence, "us." What makes it interesting is that it does not agree with an earlier pronoun in the sentence which is "your." The "someone" was casting out demons in Jesus' name and the disciples try to stop him because he was not following whom? Jesus? Not Jesus, but "us," the disciples. The real question here is: are they worried about Jesus? or are they worried about themselves? Is it Jesus' toes that have been trod upon or the disciples? Are they defending Jesus or their own positions of power and influence? Jesus answers in three proverbs, all of which make clear that he does not feel in the least offended or threatened. Jesus is about proclaiming and enacting the kingdom – however that gets done is just fine with him. We do a lot of boundary defending in almost every aspect of our lives – that us/them mentality is everywhere, not just politics! We waste a lot of time and energy in distinguishing ourselves from other good people not for the sake of the kingdom but to tout ourselves and our own brand.

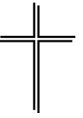
BREAKING OPEN THE SCRIPTURE WITH FR. CHRIS
