Corpus Christi Has Gluten-Free Hosts

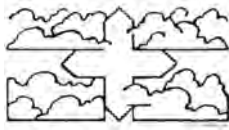

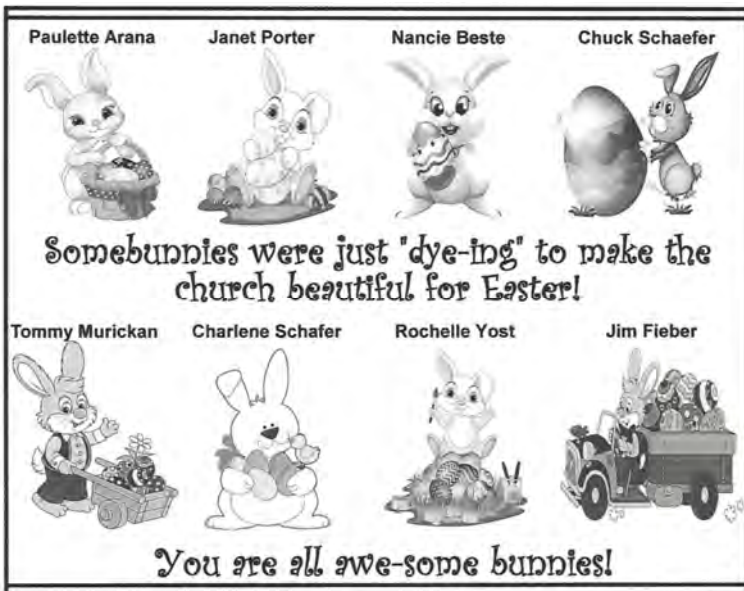
