From the Desk of Fr. Chris



I caught a story years ago about a blind hurdler, and in it she was asked how she was able to do it, running full speed and clearing the hurdles without seeing them. She responded, "Trust and guts." That's a pretty good description of faith. Faith is much more than just assenting to a list of propositions or acknowledging a fact. It's a way of describing relationship – with one another and with God. It takes trust, which is never impersonal. Trust requires vulnerability, allowing another to hold my life in their hands and risking the possibility they may let go. Can I entrust my life to God? That's the most basic question. And that takes guts – overcoming fear and daring to trust, remembering who God has been and sure of who God will be. Faith is not just in the head, but of the heart. "Faith is confident assurance concerning what we hope for, and conviction about things we do not see."

Suggested items

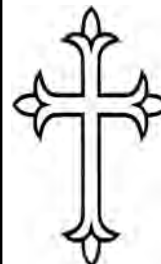
Food: peanut butter/jelly; rice; beans; broth; canned vegetables; onions; potatoes; snack-size desserts

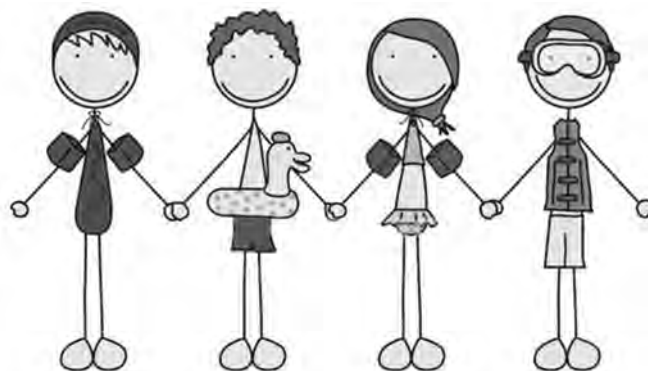
