Of all the New Testament texts, Hebrews is the most unique, falling into its own category. Sometimes you may hear it introduced as "The Letter of Paul to the Hebrews" but that's pretty inaccurate. I had a professor that used to call it "The...of...to" because it wasn't written by Paul, its audience wasn't a strictly Jewish community, and it definitely isn't a letter but an exhortation or essay. It is rich in Jewish imagery (hence its name) while being written in the most polished Greek of any Biblical text. I have always found this text difficult to really embrace. But today we have an image we can all relate to – a race, discipleship as a race. Picture it! We've all been entered into the race by virtue of our baptism. All the spectators, our ancestors in faith, gathered around to cheer us on. We strip ourselves of the warm-up outfits, all that stuff that can hold us back and make us stumble, on the way to the starting block. We know the race is long and tiring, but we're determined to finish. We give it our all and won't lose heart, knowing that our leader has prepared us well and shown us the way. Run well, my friends!
