We have a lot of Baptism language in the second reading from Colossians today. Did you catch it? "You were raised with Christ, you have died, you too will appear with him in glory, you have taken off the old self... you have put on the new self." The letter does emphasize the risen life as a present reality for the baptized, while also recognizing the imperative to constantly and actively seek to live out the risen life. What is most interesting about this passage is the shift from the individual to the community. We have been given this gift, this invitation, this new life not for ourselves, but for others. There is how we participate in the risen life of Jesus, not what we gain, but what others will gain through us.
