For the first few weeks of Advent, we think about the end times and the Parousia, commonly defined as the second coming of Christ, though the word literally means "the presence or arrival." My guess is that we take it just about as seriously as the pre-flight safety announcement we've heard a million times and can recite along with the flight attendants." Corpus Christi Has Gluten-Free Hosts




