It would be wonderful to have the letters they sent to Paul to get a fuller idea of what was going on, but we get a sense of their struggles by Paul's response. There are two ways to look at them. In a negative light they're at their most base; individuals and groups vying for power and importance and status, the in-crowd and the out-crowd, jealousies of all types seem to abound - how could Paul even associate with such a group? In the positive, they're a fledgling Christian community trying to figure out what it means to be a disciple and embrace this new life of love. They're much like any other Christian community through the ages. Their struggles are just out in the open, thanks to Paul, for all to see. Notice, Paul never gives up on them, but is always reminding them that everything is about and from the one Spirit, one Lord, one God. No two individuals are the same, yet we're all one - we're all in this together moving in the same direction.
