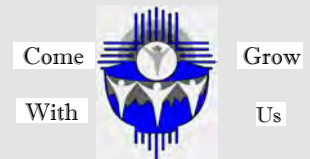

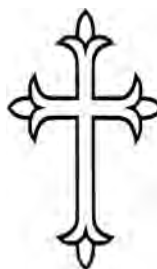

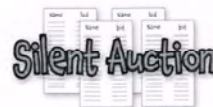

Centering Prayer

Centering Prayer is a form of contemplative prayer, wordless, in which a person simply experiences God's presence. It was developed in the 1970's by Trappist monks to revive the Christian contemplative tradition. The name 'centering prayer' was derived from Trappist Thomas Merton, who once noted that contemplative prayer is "centered entirely in the presence of God."

There is an opportunity each week to join in contemplative Centering Prayer at Corpus Christi on Wednesdays at 1pm. All are welcome to join.
