I've often wondered if there were more than 72 that Jesus told to go out with nothing, and come back with no ego or vanity. Fear can be overwhelming and paralyzing – the fear of failure, the fear of rejection, the fear of embarrassment. Courage is a deeply personal thing, but I think it draws from a well of communal support. We are after all meant to help each other, support each other, and bolster one another. It might be why Jesus sent them out in pairs, two by two - to help, to support, to bolster, to enCOURAGE one another.


