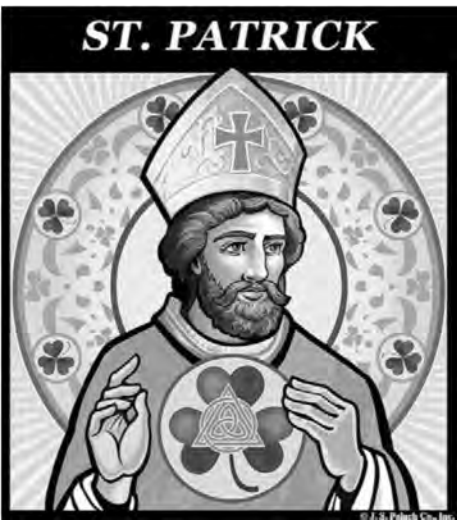
PLEASE PRAY WITH US
