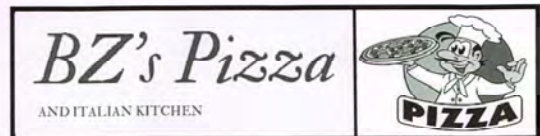

### MARY, QUEEN OF ANGELS (first in a series)

When Mary is seated beside her Divine Son, angels are often envisioned placing a crown upon her head. The name is also tied to the Assumption of Mary into Heaven, and described in Revelation as a "woman clothed with the sun, on the head, a crown of twelve stars." (Rev. 12:1) As a reward for her holiness and perfection of virtues, she has dominion over the Angels and Saints as their queen. The sweetness of her manner endears her to the everlasting kingdom of love. The angels bow low before her, as the Angel Gabriel did a Nazareth. They recognize her bright spirit as full of grace and they are thrilled with delight as forever they proclaim her, "blessed among women." She is a prodigy of divine wisdom and omnipotence, the "crown of all the saints."
