This story of Naaman feels like we've come in on the last episode of a five night mini-series. A little background to set the stage. Naaman, an Aramean General with leprosy, hears there might be a cure in Israel and seeks permission to go to Israel's king. The King is suspicious of this foreigner and thinks this is a pretense for war. Elisha hears of this and is going to put the general in his place! Arrogantly, he tells the king to "let him come to me and I will show him a prophet!" Elisha doesn't even go out to meet the great general, but sends a curt message with the simple task for Naaman to wash in the Jordan. Naaman has come all this way, groveling, and this is what he gets? He's hurt and frustrated, but grudgingly he goes. And in spite of everyone resisting and standing on their dignity and wounded pride, God is still able to pull off a healing. Think of what God could do in us and in our world if we would stop resisting. if we would stop troubling about our own prominence and let God's prominence come first, if our pride, our frustrations and hurt feelings, came second to God's will.

- 1) At the home page, click "Sign In For Online Education"
- 2) Complete the fields for your First Name, Last Name and Home street address. Click "Search". The system may ask you to review your personal information.

If you have not been on the site previously a red-lettered notice will come up indicating that there is no record for you in the system
-Click "Click here to Create a Record" and follow the instructions.
(e.g. fill in your information: name, phone, e-mail address, etc.)
-Note: The "Location" is Corpus Christi Parish. Use the drop down menu to select your "Position" volunteer, and "Title" is whatever ministry you are involved in.

- -Click "Add New Record and Continue"
- 3) Once at the "List of Courses" select the Ministry to Vulnerable Adults video.
- 4) At the end of the video, you will be given the opportunity to view the Code of Conduct and the Summary of the Guidelines if you do not have them at hand, then you will need to complete a guiz.
- 5) Upon successful completion of the quiz a certificate will be emailed to the address you entered previously. Print the email, sign it, and return it to your Compliance Officer by mail or email.


