From the Desk of Fr. Chris



The consensus opinion of scholars is that 2 Timothy was not in fact written by Paul, but written within his school of thought by the generation after him, reflecting the conditions of that current generation and seeking to preserve his teaching in the new situation. The line "I remind you to stir into flame the gift of God that you have through the imposition of my hands" is interesting. We see the liturgical practice of imposing hands is already part of the early Church and may even have been a practice of Paul. It is indeed an action we continue today, not just with ordination, but also the Sacraments of Anointing and Confirmation. Flame, gift, and imposition are words that point to Confirmation. A few among us have just started their journey toward the Sacrament of Confirmation, and let us remember to keep them in our prayers. Also, as we celebrate 20 years as a parish, we pray for every member of our parish, that we all have the courage and strength to "stir into flame the gift of God" we have received!

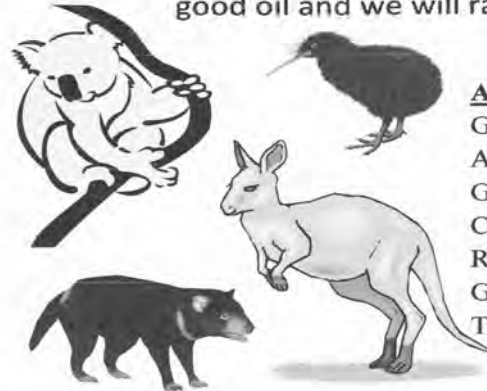

1) At the home page, click "Sign In For Online Education"
2) Complete the fields for your First Name, Last Name and Home street address. Click "Search". The system may ask you to review your personal information.

If you have not been on the site previously a red-lettered notice will come up indicating that there is no record for you in the system

-Click "Click here to Create a Record" and follow the instructions.

(e.g. fill in your information: name, phone, e-mail address, etc.)

-Note: The "Location" is Corpus Christi Parish. Use the drop down menu to select your "Position" volunteer, and "Title" is whatever ministry you are involved in.

-Click "Add New Record and Continue"

3) Once at the "List of Courses" select the Ministry to Vulnerable Adults video.

4) At the end of the video, you will be given the opportunity to view the Code of Conduct and the Summary of the Guidelines if you do not have them at hand, then you will need to complete a quiz.

5) Upon successful completion of the quiz a certificate will be emailed to the address you entered previously. Print the email, sign it, and return it to your Compliance Officer by mail or email.

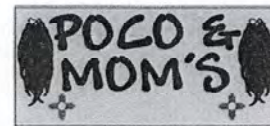
