"My child, conduct your affairs with humility..." is the first line from the Sirach reading this week. What does a humble person look like? Who in your life models humility for you? They see the dignity of other people no matter their lot in life. What would you add? The common theme seems to be the "other." Other is a catch-all for anyone and everybody else, friend and foe, family and stranger, people we've known forever or those on the other side of the world we will never meet in this lifetime. May we all be humble people!

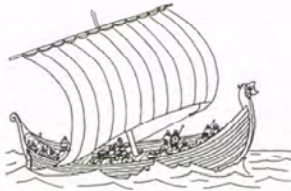
### **Corpus Christi Has Gluten-Free Hosts**
