I have a friend that won't put his Christmas decorations away until the Feast of the Presentation. He says this is the true end to the Christmas season. He may have a point. Many of the themes hearken back to Christmas. Simeon's proclamation of a "Light of revelation to the gentiles" reminds us of Isaiah's "the people who walked in darkness have seen a great light." In England this feast is known as Candlemas because this is the day candles were blessed in procession. But the theme of light permeates the entire Church year. At the Easter Vigil we use the ancient chant "Christ our Light" as we process with the Easter Candle. This feast is a reminder that we are called to both allow Jesus to illumine our hearts so we may look upon others with his light, and to be a light to others so they may recognize him.






