"You are the salt of the earth." I'm always tempted by this Gospel to stand up and say, "You heard Jesus! Go be salty," but I know that's not what Jesus meant. In fact, quite the opposite! There are enough "salty" individuals running around, and that's not the stance of a disciple. In modern times salt has fallen out of favor, but historically it's a good thing. Salt is used as a preservative so food will not spoil. It wakes up the taste buds so all the subtle flavors come forth.

Note that Jesus doesn't tell us to become the salt of the earth; he says this is who we are already. We season and flavor the world already because we are disciples. 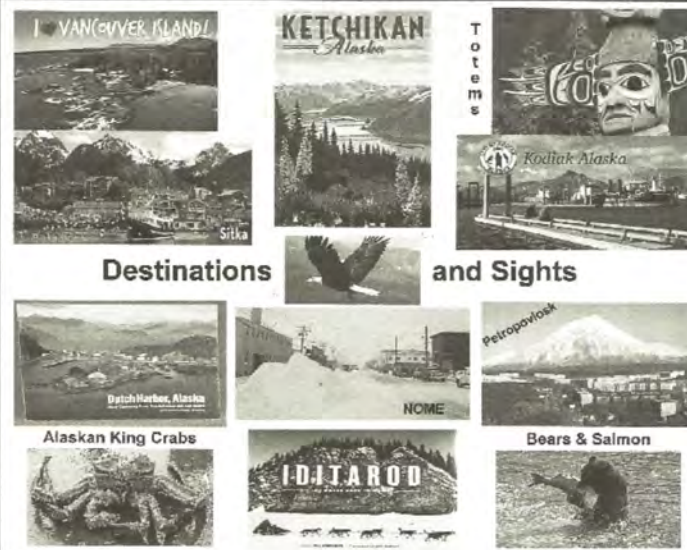
