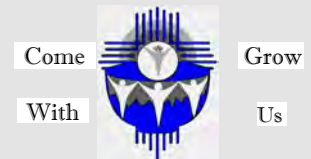

Epiphany - a sudden, intuitive perception of or insight into the reality or essential meaning of something, usually initiated by some simple, homely, or commonplace occurrence or experience. It comes from the Greek word, Epi-phanein, to manifest or appear. Literally it means to shine upon. So, Feast of Epiphany commemorates the first manifestation of Christ to the Gentiles. These astrologers from the East, these Gentiles, have an Epiphany. They have a sudden, intuitive insight into reality initiated by a simple occurrence. They recognize the Messiah wrapped up in his mother's arms. We are beginning a new year. We pray this year will be a year of Epiphanyes for us, that we may recognize the Christ in the commonplace and in the ordinary.

Becoming Catholic

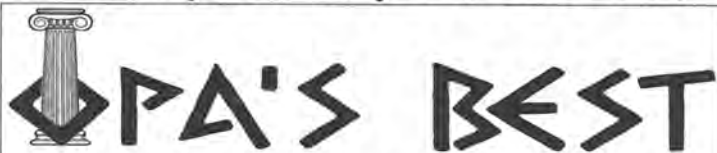

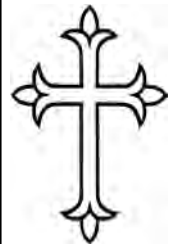
Have You Moved?
