

From the Desk of Fr. Chris



We have one of the most clear Trinitarian passages in the New Testament in the second reading today. It is also quite liturgical. After signing ourselves with the Trinitarian formula, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, this would be a familiar greeting to all of us - "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ and the love of God and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with all of you." Also note the sign, or kiss, of peace just before. Perhaps Paul's letter would be read to the entire community just before they celebrated Eucharist. More than just a greeting or dogmatic proclamation of the Trinity, Paul is describing not only his experience, but the Corinthians' experience and our experience of the Trinity - grace, love, and fellowship. I like this quote about the Trinity from Rev. Reginald Fuller - "It is in Jesus Christ and his gracious life and death that we encounter the love of God, and this encounter leads to our incorporation into the redeemed community, in which we participate in the common life of the Spirit."
