

Blood Drive

Corpus Christ Parish is sponsoring our first blood drive for 2021 with COVID-19 safety precautions in place.

The blood drive is Sunday February 7 from 7:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Blood donations are by appointment only. Please register to donate on the American Red Cross (ARC) website ww.redcrossblood.org and complete the Rapid Pass the morning of the drive at www.redcrossblood.org/RapidPass. All donors, volunteers, and staff will be required to wear masks or cloth face covering, practice physical distancing, and a sanitation station (gloves, hand sanitizer and disinfectant wipes) will be available. All donors will receive free COVID-Antibody screening also. To prepare for your donation hydrate well, eat a healthy breakfast and wear light, loose, comfortable clothing.

CTSO - We have great news! The Individual Tax Credit limits have increased the amount you can now contribute to Arizona's Catholic Tuition Support Organization (CTSO) has increased. If filing as a single taxpayer you can give up to \$1,183, and a married couple filing jointly can contribute up to \$2,365, and you, the donor can receive a dollar-for-dollar tax credit off your Arizona tax liability. 




The Joy of Love: Spiritual Enrichment for Catholic Couples


