From the Desk of Fr. Chris 

I caught a story years ago about a blind hurdler, and she was asked how she was able to do it, running full speed and clearing the hurdles without seeing them. She responded, "Trust and guts." That's a pretty good description of faith. Faith is much more than just assenting to a list of propositions or acknowledging a fact. It's a way of describing relationship – with one another and with God. It takes trust, which is always personal. Trust requires vulnerability, allowing another to hold my life in their hands and risking the possibility they may let go. Can I entrust my life to God? That's the most basic question. And that takes guts – overcoming fear and daring to trust, remembering who God has been and sure of who God will be. Faith is not just in the head, but of the heart. "Faith is confident assurance concerning what we hope for, and conviction about things we do not see."

Family Faith Formation Religious Education Program for Parents and Children

When we had our children baptized, we promised to raise them in the Catholic faith. It was not a promise most of us took lightly, but how do we bring our faith in God and Jesus into the home? Many parents feel they are unqualified and don't even know where to start.

Family Faith Formation is a ministry at Corpus Christi that focuses on providing parents with the inspiration and tools to share the Catholic faith with their children. Starting in October, the group will begin meeting the first Sunday of the month before 9:45 mass. Each month focuses on a particular theme centered around the teachings of the Church. The families are given activities and readings to complete at home before meeting again.

This group is not just for those families who have a child preparing for First Communion. It is designed to guide the parents in continuing their own faith journey while giving them the support they need to lead their children into a life centered on Christ.

Memorial Bricks

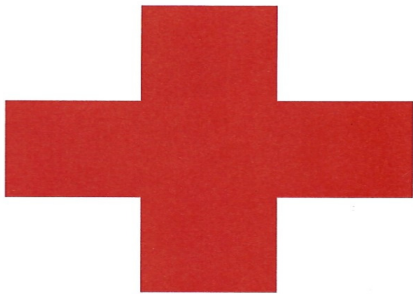
