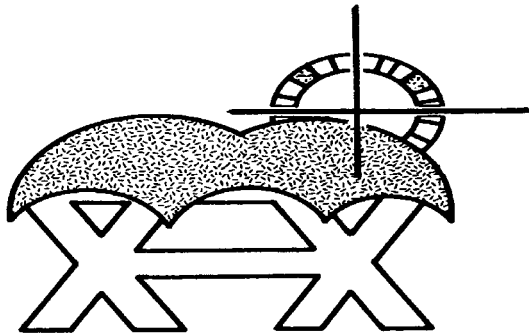
The Mission of Corpus Christi

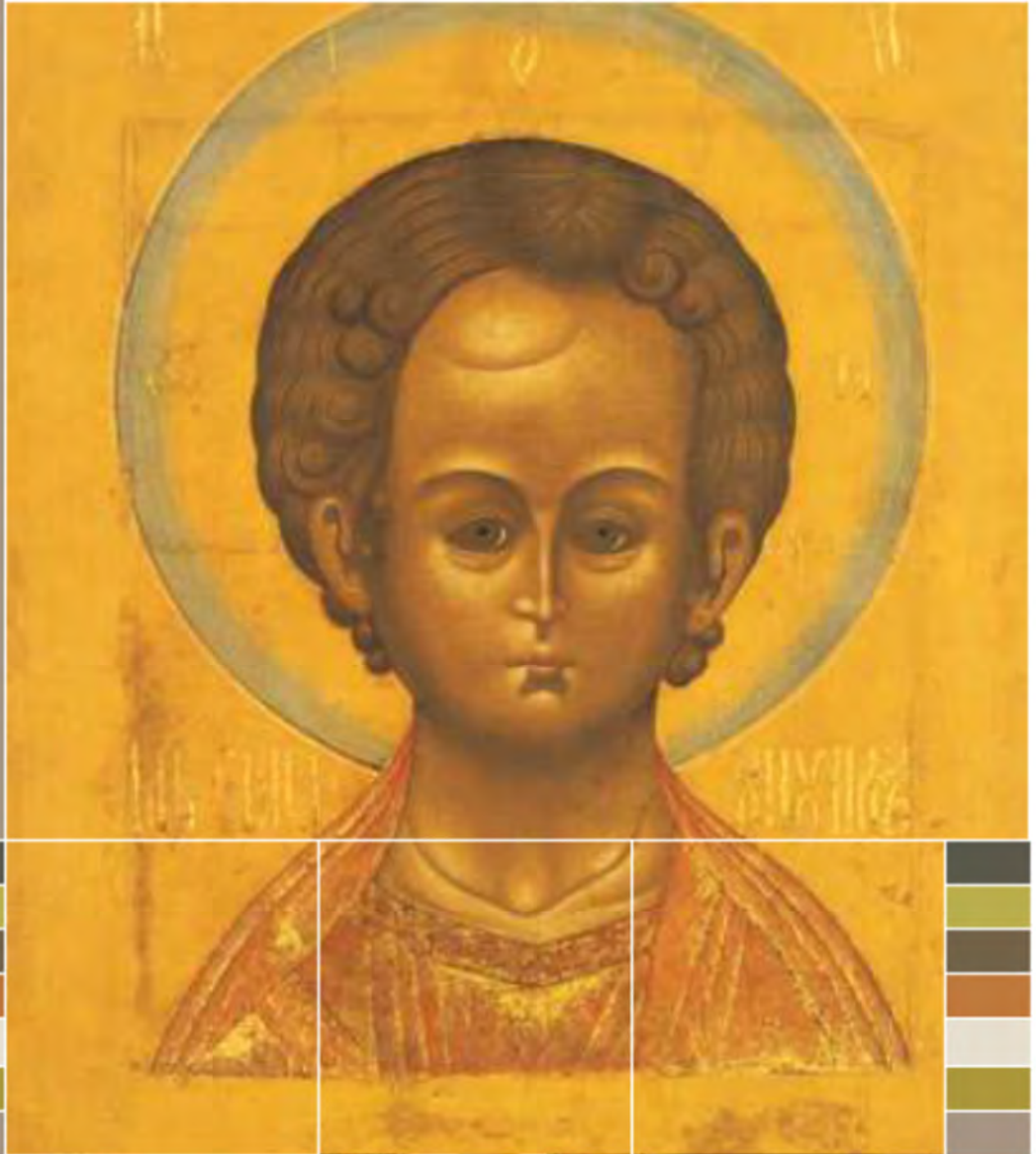

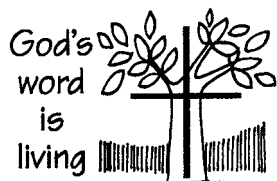
