We are a community built upon the values of compassion, dignity, and respect. For many of our guests, we are home. In 2023, vital assistance was made possible for 23,960 women. We served 46,727 meals, hosted 14,463 overnight stays.

Mass Intentions

The custom of requesting a priest to offer the Mass for a specific intention, even when one cannot be physically present at the Mass, is a longstanding tradition in the Church. An individual may ask a priest to offer a Mass for several reasons: for example, in thanksgiving, for the intentions of another person (such as on a birthday or anniversary), or, as is most common, for the repose of the soul of someone who has died. Mass Intentions at Corpus Christi are scheduled Monday—Friday, 8:00am daily Mass. If you would like to schedule a weekday Mass for your loved one(s), or have a special intention, please contact the parish office at 520-751-4235.

Attention

Our buildings and grounds are "maturing" with use and time which means there are occasional, usually minor, hazards popping up. For example, tree roots in the courtyard have begun to move brick paving in some areas so that it is no longer perfectly flat. Please be attentive to possible changes while using any of our facilities.

Plaza Fountain

Religious Education the Family Way Family Faith Formation

This month the children who are preparing for their First Communion have been focusing on the Sacrament of Reconciliation, more commonly referred to as Confession. While I've heard some Catholics express gratefulness in regards to this sacrament, most of us avoid it. Who wants to look deeply into their faults? We try to justify our actions or forget them, but that doesn't always work especially when we may hang onto the thought that it's up to us to earn acceptance.

Admitting fault might feel like we're admitting that we aren't worthy. But Jesus taught and showed that God's love is not dependent on our actions. Confession gives us an opportunity to feel that forgiveness, to hear out loud that we are forgiven, and to stop believing that we don't belong.

Even without the sacrament, it's still important to reflect on the times when we could have done better, and pray for guidance. We will never be without sin, but through forgiveness we can live more humbly and love more deeply.

OCIA: Thinking About Becoming Catholic? New Cohort Starting in May

**Are you thinking about becoming Catholic?
Do you know someone considering Catholicism?
Do you have questions about the Catholic faith?**

The Order of Christian Initiation of Adults (formerly RCIA) Inquiry sessions are designed for anyone interested in exploring the Catholic faith.
