

#### From the Desk of Fr. Chris



Happy Easter! A special thank you to all the various ministers that volunteered their time and effort to make all the different liturgies of Holy Week so special! Easter is such a special and defining feast for the Christian community. It's a feast so grand that it spans eight days, Sunday to Sunday. We'll celebrate the Easter season for fifty days until Pentecost. We fasted for 40 days during Lent; we feast for the 50 days of Easter to show that "God is greater than our hearts." (1Jn 3:20) Easter is a week of weeks  $-7 \times 7$  days +1 = 50. That extra day is eschatological, the day beyond the week, the first day of the new creation. The Feast of Weeks in Greek is "Pentecost", literally 50 days. In our Jewish roots "Pentecost" referred to the feast of Shavuot, the giving of the Torah at Mt. Sinai 50 days after Passover. For us, "Pentecost" is the celebration of the giving of the Holy Spirit, and that feast is 50 days after the Resurrection. So for the next month and a half, Happy Easter!
