2022 Retreat	a) Those members who were able to attend enjoyed the presentation - "12 Spiritual Habits for Catholic Leaders, Exploring the Spirituality of Administration," by Sr. Lois.
Formation/ Evangelization	This will be tabled until Nick has an opportunity to discuss ideas with other individuals working in this area in the diocese.
COVID Protocol Changes	a) Bob DeBolt a will set up a training session with Ushers re: passing donation baskets. Looking at September as the start date. b) Discussion about the passing of the baskets and the bringing up of the Gifts followed. Both are seen as symbolic aspects of the Mass and help the community to focus. It was suggested that perhaps the Gifts could be brought up BEFORE passing the baskets. Keeping the donation boxes in the church was also suggested.
Safe Environment/ Volunteer Clearance	a) Nancy Nichols announced at Daily Mass that all lectors and EMs should have their high clearance by July 1, 2022. There was some confusion but interested parishioners have been informed of the procedures. b) It was also suggested that a new ministry be established - the "Daily Mass Ministry."
