CCCC Mission Statement Review Committee	<p>Do we need to rename this committee to Strategic Plan Committee?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Decided that Strategic Plan comes after the Mission Statement -Council members need to submit names to Mike <p>The discussion was tabled.</p>

Report from the "Parish Reboot" Webinar	<p>Sylvia Olberding, Georgene Fromm, and Nancy Nichols attended the webinar. The major points presented were:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Faith Communities around the world are addressing many of the same issues we have been discussing. There is a "disconnect" from the faith community - a slipping away - not just from church activities but from GOD. -We need to focus on "MISSION." -Know who we are: The Body of Christ and that everyone is loved, known and welcomed -Be INTENTIONAL in what we choose to do - clarify our vision -Be INVITATIONAL: move at a scale of relationship 1:1, be DISCIPLES -Develop steps: 1)immediate needs; 2)assess everything to our MISSION; 3)look at the short term and get started; 4)tweak mid-term -There will be CONFLICT. -Let the Holy Spirit guide us. <p>Presenters were asked to consider being a part of the CCCC Mission Statement Review Committee.</p>

Review of Parish Council Objectives	<p>We need to look at our target audiences and how to engage them in our faith community. Let's choose two to begin with - 1) Youth and Families; 2)think about it.</p> <p>1. Support Fr. Chris</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -asked for prayers <p>2. Prepare for Re-Opening of Parish</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Fr. Chris reported that the reopening will be in stages -The Bishop will remove the dispensation for Mass on 1 July. -It is expected that most COVID protocols will be removed by August 2021.

Review of Parish Council Objectives (con't)	<p>There are still many questions about reopening: Meals? - NO - Gatherings? - YES</p> <p>3. Evangelization (spreading the WORD) - previously discussed -Will probably need a subcommittee (Sylvia is being encouraged to lead this . . .)</p> <p>4. Youth Engagement -Discussion ensued as to the "age group/s" this objective encompasses. *After high school *18-40 *always difficult to discern needs for all the ages in this group</p> <p>-A STUDY HALL/COFFEE BAR idea was suggested by Paul Sayre as a means to getting college-aged kids onto the church "campus." -A subcommittee will probably be needed for this objective</p> <p>5. A Need to be More Welcoming (Let's pray on this.)</p>

"Getting Ready for Sunday" podcast	<p>Paul Sayre reported that Dcn Mark was getting positive feedback on this 20-minute audio podcast.</p> <p>-Should Fr. Chris mention it on his robo calls? -This is EVANGELIZING using technology. -How can we "market" this? -The trivia questions after Mass are another way to engage our youth. -Can we come up with other ideas using social media? (Catholicism 101, etc.) -Teach "How to share with a friend."</p>
